President's Report



As referenced in the May/June Current we have contracted with Giffels-Webster Engineers, Inc, Englewood, FL. The (4) troubled areas of Lazy River have been inspected by their engineers and the necessary corrections are currently being evaluated.

- 1) Repair/replace the Bocce Courts
- 2) Survey and repair Lake Frangipani, Antigua Lake and the drainage to the Martinique Canal. (L&T Engineering)
- 3) Survey the Marina canal bank and Island Point Rd roadway for erosion and roadway stability. (Giffels-Webster Engineers, Inc.)
- 4) Survey and repair cul-de-sac drainage across and under #102 Lazy River Rd., which includes under the driveway, the house and seawall.

These drawings will not be ready until around the middle/end of July.

We had planned to be able to start sooner, before the summer rains, but the need to change the engineering firm caused long delays in our schedule. The rains have arrived before the final plans and construction contracts have been completed. By the time you receive this report we should be back on track.

The front walls new/repaired lighting should have been completed by the end of June. Please report to the office any outages along the outside walls and front entrance after June 30, 2021.

The in-house population has declined to about 138 residents and declining. Please be aware of your neighbor and their well-being. We all need to look out for one another.

We have distributed about 16 copies of the **All-Hazards Disaster Planning Guides**, published by Sarasota County, to those who do not have email addresses. **Please pay special attention to pages 7 thru 12 and page 15 if you have pets.**

Maintenance has built a concrete step-down at the Marina from the dock to the concrete ramp. Erosion had made a dangerous drop-off when stepping off the dock to the concrete ramp. As always, please be aware of your footing when stepping down onto the ramp when it is wet or slippery, usually, with slime. Please replace the chain across the ramp opening after loading or unloading your boat or kayak.

Veterans Memorial



Repeat of Phil Donelson's speech on Memorial Day.

Memorial Day 2021 May 31, 2021, 1:00 PM

Good afternoon and welcome to this Memorial Day ceremony.

We pause today to remember those brave and courageous military men and women who made the ultimate sacrifice in service of their country. Each year, on the last Monday in May, we honor these heroes, who died in battle, or died from their wounds sustained in battle.

Our country has endured several foreign wars in modern history, beginning with World War I in Europe, extending to the far-off desert sands of Afghanistan, all in an effort to protect and defend the principles of our democracy. These young patriots heeded the call, and found themselves in foreign lands, fighting for what they believed to be a noble cause, never to return to live the life they had been given.

One of my favorite symbols of remembrance is the red poppy. In the torn battlefields of Europe, the common red poppy was one of the first plants to reappear. Its seeds, scattered in the wind and sat dormant in the grounds, only germinating when the ground was disturbed as it was by the very brutal fighting of World War One. It became a tradition to wear and to distribute an artificial red poppy as a symbol of remembrance. There is a beautiful poem titled "In Flander's Field", by **Lt. Col. John McCrae**, written in May, 1915, that beautifully tells the story. If you would indulge me for a couple of minutes, I would like to share it with you.

In Flanders Fields



**In Flanders fields the poppies blow
Between the crosses, row on row,
That mark our place; and in the sky
The larks, still bravely singing, fly
Scarce heard amid the guns below.**

**We are the Dead. Short days ago
We lived, felt dawn, saw sunset glow,
Loved and were loved, and now we lie
In Flanders fields.**

**Take up our quarrel with the foe:
To you from failing hands we throw
The torch; be yours to hold it high.
If ye break faith with us who die
We shall not sleep, though poppies grow
In Flanders fields.**

Today we solemnly show our gratitude and thanks to those who have fallen, for it is because of them, we live a life of liberty and peace. As Americans we should be eternally grateful and never forget their sacrifice that was made for us, and for the country they loved. May these brave souls rest in peace for all eternity in the presence of their creator, and may you always sense in your heart, that you have been blessed by them, whom you did not know. My friends, truly I say to you, freedom is not free, but the cost has been paid for you and for me. May God bless the United States of America
